## **Commercial Training**

For those students who wish to fly helicopters professionally, a commercial rating is the next phase. This stage of your training will build on skills learned during your private pilot training. You will also master more advanced maneuvers typically found in commercial operations like confined areas, slope landings and additional emergency procedures.

Although not necessary for a commercial rating, an Instrument rating will allow a pilot to fly referencing his or her instruments, without the need to look outside. Due to the fact that some helicopter operations may take place in inclement weather, many companies are now requiring an instrument rating be eligible for employment.
